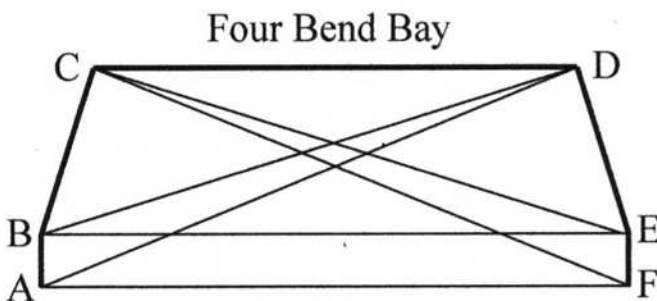
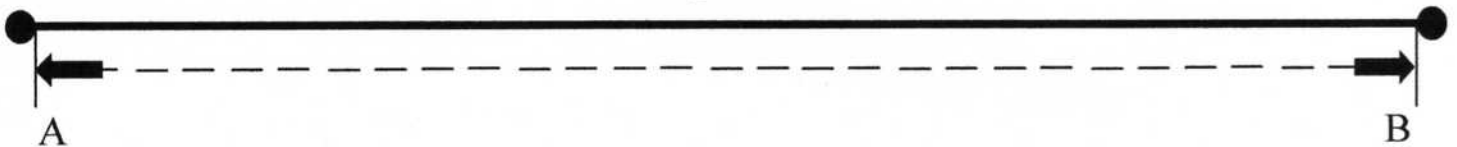


MERE BROW SMITHY BAY WINDOW CURTAIN POLES

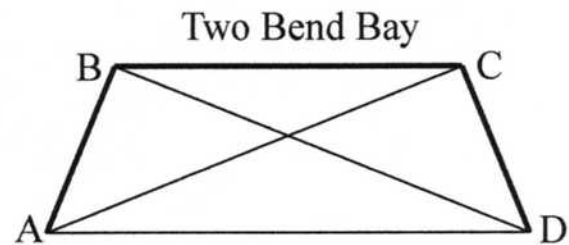
How To Measure Your Curtain Poles.

1. Select your bay window from the sketches shown below.
2. **Measurements** must be taken at the height at which the pole is to be fixed and from the exact points on the wall face as indicated below (we will allow for the pole's projection, 60mm, from the wall when it is made). Unless you instruct us otherwise, finals will be excluded from the measurements supplied.
3. Bays carry a surcharge of £20 per bend to cover extra work involved.
4. Measure the exact length of the pole you need between points A—B (excluding the final lengths). We suggest you add an extra 7—13cm past either side of your window frame to allow for curtain gather, brackets and final attachments. (*NB—Poles can always be shortened, NOT lengthened!*)

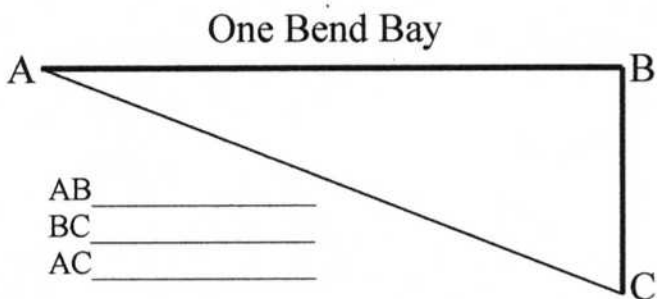
Straight Pole



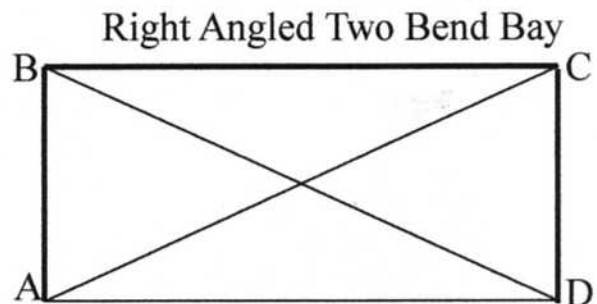
